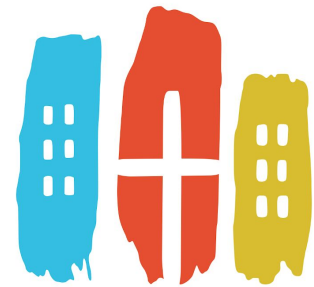


Fifth Sunday after Epiphany
