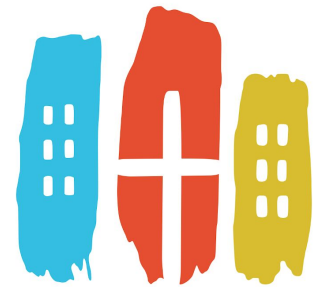


Fourth Sunday of Eastertide
